

Required Training for HIV Early Intervention Services Workers

Rapid HIV Testing & Prevention Counseling

This 2-part course must be completed by nurses or counselors prior to becoming HIV Early Intervention Services (EIS) workers.

Part 1 is custom-designed for high impact. The 2-day workshop is interactive and based on a CDC-mandated curriculum. Spending time in both classroom and lab, trainees participate in hands-on role play under direct observation to assure that quality standards are being met.

Part 2 is a one-day booster in the form of a clinical consultation that allows participants to return to the classroom after launching rapid HIV testing at their agencies. Trainees receive extensive coaching and additional quality assurance time in the lab under direct observation.
